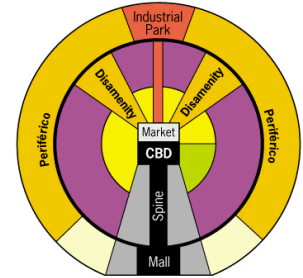

A NEW AND IMPROVED MODEL OF LATIN AMERICAN CITY STRUCTURE

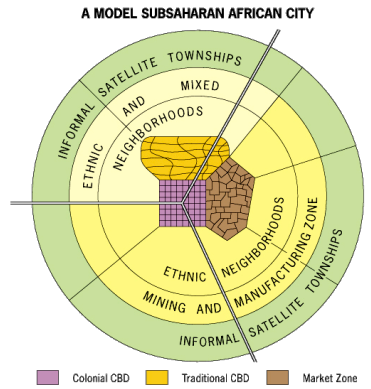
